Thank you for purchasing the Airaid Intake System. Please read the instruction manual carefully before proceeding with the installation. Contact Airaid @ (800) 498-6951: 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM MST Weekdays for questions regarding fit or instructions that are not clear to you. Your Airaid Intake System was carefully inspected and packaged. Check that no parts are missing or damaged during shipping. If any parts are missing, contact Airaid. The air filter element is protected from direct exposure to water and debris in its new location. Care should be taken not to drive through deep water. **WATER INGESTION IS THE DRIVERS RESPONSIBILITY!** The air filter is reusable and should be cleaned using the Airaid Filter Tune-Up Kit periodically.

Included with your Airaid Intake System is a sticker with a **California Air Resources Board (C.A.R.B.) Executive Order (EO) number**. This sticker must be placed in plain view inside of the engine compartment. Failure to do so may prevent you from passing a smog inspection.

Installation Instructions. Read Me!

I DISCONNECT NEGATIVE (-) BATTERY CABLE.

II Remove air filter.

- Loosen clamp and separate. Remove filter.
- Remove the **FRONT** half of air box, simply “pull up” to release. No tools needed. **See Fig#2**
- These parts are not reinstalled in Airaid kit.
- CAUTION: Do Not remove the REAR half of the air box or the “V”-BAND CLAMP.**

III Remove air cleaner bracket.

- Unbolt the 4 retaining bolts (10mm), and remove the bracket (**See Fig#2**) from the engine compartment.
- Save the 4 bolts to reuse later. The bracket is not reused.

IV Assemble Airaid Cool Air Dam.

- Bolt the two panels together with the supplied #6 hardware. **See Fig#1**
- Bolt the Filter Adapter to the Back Panel with the supplied 1/4” hardware.

V Install in vehicle.

- Set in place of the removed bracket.
- Use the 4 saved 10mm bolts to fasten the Airaid assembly into the existing bracket mounting holes.

VI Connect to Airaid.

- Slip supplied Rubber Gasket onto the 4.5” stub on the end of the Airaid assembly. This gasket will make a seal between the Airaid and the stock rear half once connected. **Be sure gasket is in place.**
- Slide stock rear half toward the Airaid and secure with the factory “V”-BAND CLAMP.
- Press weather seal on to top edge of air box.

VII Finishing up

- Check that no foreign objects are in the intake path.**
- Check throttle linkage for full open and closed travel.
- Reconnect battery terminal. Enjoy!

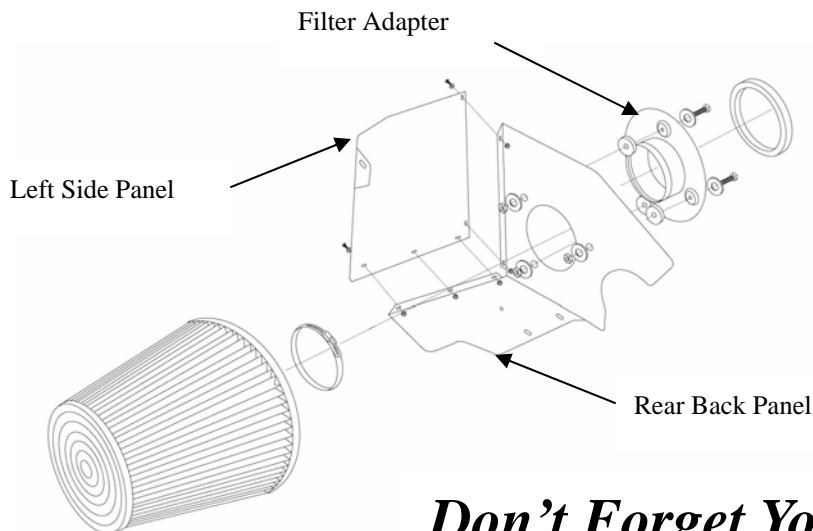
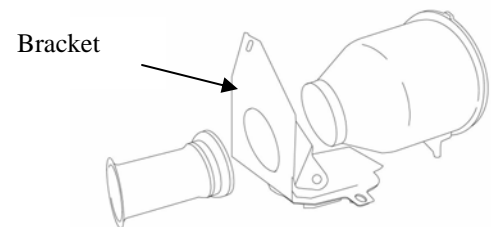
